Additional Jobs	Prepare for your garden by incorporating organic matter into the soil Check cabbage, broccoli, and cauliflower for caterpillars. (September) Unripen Tomatoes in a brown bag	Digging over the soil Add fallen leaves to the compost bins	Remember to keep mulch around your vegetable plants to conserve moisture and reduce weed problems. (January)  Digging over the soil	Mound up soil around potato stems to protect tubers from sun damage. (March)  Stake tomatoes at the time of planting or soon after with a rigid stake that is at least five feet tall. This will help keep fruit off the ground. (April)
